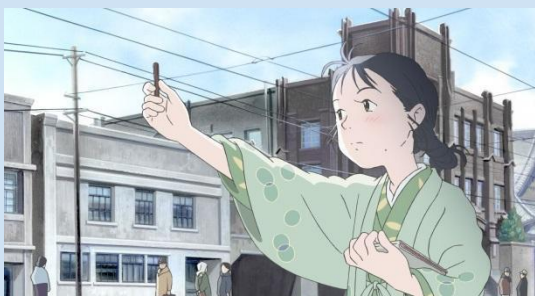
Samurai sci-fi comedy chaos!
